2-OBJECTIVE OF THE COURSE:

Brain death declaration for pregnant cases who had brain death at neurological intensive care, coping with challenging situations such as status epilepticus and stroke treatment. Is it possible to decide on intracerebral haemorrhage in the grey zone, take tracheostomy decisions and increase wakefulness while in coma?

3-WHAT WILL BE THE LEARNING OUTCOMES THAT THE PARTICIPANTS WILL ACQUIRE AT THE END OF THE COURSE?

Participants will be informed about brain death in pregnant cases, status epilepticus and stroke treatment. Decision for surgery in case of intracerebral haemorrhage, tracheostomy and medications used to increase wakefulness while in coma.
